It includes a six foot sleigh covered in red chocolate, which is filled with edible showpiece toys including a skateboard, xylophone, Mr. Potato Head, Raggedy Ann, Nintendo games, iPods, stuffed animals, elves and more.

The display is built with Rice Krispy treats covered in sugar, then decorated with all edible mediums. The sled is being pulled by a team of reindeer covered in milk, white and dark chocolate. The reindeer's eyes, hooves, noses and ears are made of icing and sugar, fondant, chocolate and edible gold. Ingredients used for the project include:

- 67 pounds of colored icing fondant
- 45 pounds of chocolate
- 28 pounds of red, white, milk and dark cocoa butter
- 15 pounds of marshmallows
- 20 boxes of Rice Krispies

Chef Nash gave her team free reign relative to all design aspects of the toys they created. She encouraged them to craft an item that personally resonated with them. "I really wanted everyone to be engaged in the process. I encouraged them to take chances and to have fun." It is clear by the level of detail used in creating the toy showpieces, that her directives were fully embraced. The end product is an amazing holiday presentation that is sure to make children of all ages smile.
